Formal Insolvency

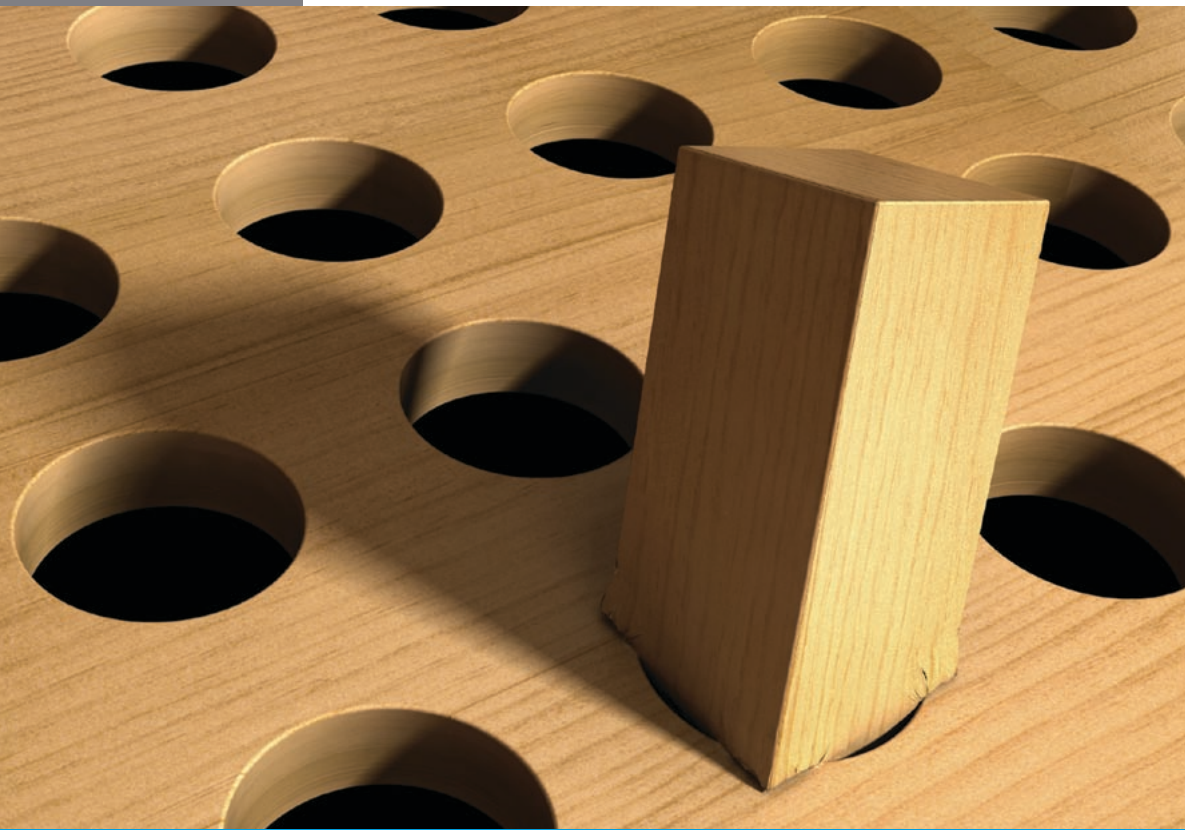
